### GROUP ACTIVITY:

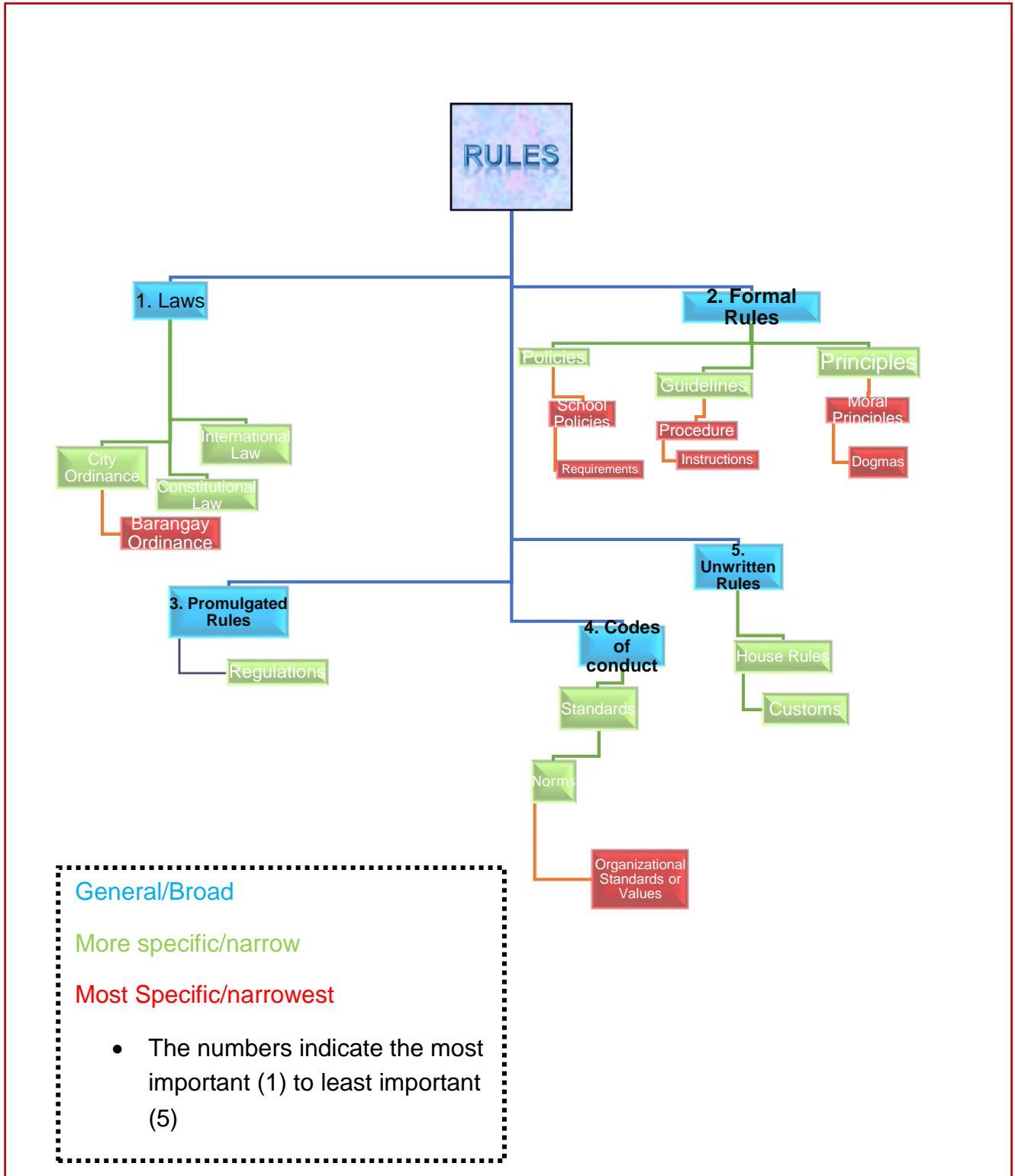
- a. Form a dyad or group yourselves into two (pair).
