

INFORMATION ON THE “ SILENT NO MORE PH “ BLOG :

The people behind the “Silent No More” blog are :

1. Mellissa Limcaoco
2. Edwin Lacierda
3. Abigail Valte
4. Leah Navarro

The group hired an operator named **Cocoy Dayao** to run the blog for them. Cocoy was a former Malacañang digital consultant during the Pinoy administration.



Cocoy is the operator while Limcaoco-Lacierda-Valte are the directors. Note that Mellissa Limcaoco is the wife of the former DOTC head. The family owns the Laguna-based thrift bank LDB – where Andy Bautista keeps his millions. Mellissa is also one of the major stockowners in Rappler. She now heads the Digital Transformation department at ABS CBN.

The group reports directly to Robredo & also to PNoy (through Bam Aquino).

The **digital agency** of the yellows (with Cocoy as one of its **biggest suppliers**) is Xabine Inc :

Xabine Inc. also has a branch in the United States. The branch is owned & operated by Loida Lewis' daughter, Christina Lewis-Halpern.



Christina was a former staff writer of the Wall Street Journal. She still maintains contact with her colleagues. This would explain the **negative** reports on the EJKs and human rights abuses that have been hounding the Duterte administration for the last 1 ½ years.

The **modus operandi** of the “Liberal & Lewis” [“L+L”] connection is as follows :

1st : the Wall Street Journal, New York Times and other US-based publications will print a **negative** article about Duterte &/or his supporters

2nd: the a **negative** article will suddenly be “picked up” by “Silent No More.PH” ; however, when the blog has no negative article to pick up, it will **invent** “fake news” about Duterte &/or his supporters and will disseminate this to the public;

3rd : the blog will try to make the info **VIRAL** (whether **real** news or **fake** news) ; but since the blog doesn’t have a lot of “die hard” followers, the group will boost their so-called “news” by buying ads & boosting the “likes” its supposed followers :



4th : since the company has a U.S. branch, it is easy for Loida Lewis to fund its activities

It is important to note that Loida Lewis already financed activities such as these in 2013. This is what prompted former CamSur Rep. Luis Villafuerte to file 6 cases against

her for electioneering & violation of the Election Code. These cases (and all its supporting evidence) have been pending in the DOJ & the Comelec since 2013;

The **modus operandi** would explain why the yellows are **winning** the media war when it comes to spreading :

- negative news regarding the Duterte administration (EJKs etc)
- present-day human rights abuses & Martial Law horror stories
- hidden wealth issues against the Marcos family
- other topics which want to divide the Filipino nation

The game plan of the “L+L connection” is to oust Duterte from office and install Robredo as President of the Philippines. **Their plan is already in motion.** Unfortunately, the Duterte administration is either too **blind** or too **promdi** to see it!!

How will they achieve this?

- 1st : they will control the **narrative** ;

- 4th : they will **collect dirt & throw mud** at Duterte;
